A key component of Los Angeles International Airport's (LAX) Landside Access Modernization Program (LAMP) is to leverage the Automated People Mover (APM) project to re-vision the economic future of Los Angeles by investing in its people and economy in a manner which reflects the local community. By incorporating innovative and proactive strategies into a comprehensive Inclusivity Program that focuses on outreach, youth engagement and charitable giving, LAX Integrated Express Solutions (LINXS) and the APM project will provide career development opportunities to under-represented stakeholders.

Creating Pathways



LINXS' youth engagement and K-12 mentoring efforts support existing age-appropriate STEM teaching modules by helping to educate youth and recent graduates about careers in engineering and construction. By providing them with career development opportunities, LINXS' youth outreach will seek to leave a lasting legacy in the designated Airport Impact Area.



As part of Engineers Week 2020, LINXS partnered with local schools to help inspire the next generation of engineers in Los Angeles. LINXS' Youth Engagement team presented at Lennox Middle School, where students received an overview of the APM project, learned about careers in the field of engineering and participated in a hands-on activity that encouraged students to brainstorm ways to enhance the APM ridership experience in the future.

Age-Appropriate Programming

Through LINXS' "Pathways to Engineering" programming, students of all ages from local schools learn about the APM project and are guided through age-appropriate workshops and activities designed to introduce them to STEM concepts and engineering career tracks. Kindergarten students may be asked to construct the APM guideway out of wooden blocks, while high school students may build their own robot using household materials as they learn more about different fields of engineering.

Career Development Opportunities

By offering scholarships, summer internship opportunities and supporting career fairs, LINXS is working to help establish a pipeline of construction and engineering professionals that will build Los Angeles' future. At the 11th Annual Construction Careers Awareness day at Los Angeles Southwest College, LINXS provided \$20k in charitable giving for event support and scholarships in 2019, while team members volunteered as featured speakers and workshop facilitators.

About the Automated People Mover

The Automated People Mover (APM) system will bring convenience and time-certainty for guests traveling to or from Los Angeles International Airport (LAX). During peak hours, driverless trains will arrive at stations every two minutes. The trains will have wide doors for easy access with luggage, large windows for viewing, plenty of hand holds and seats for those in need. Station platforms are open-air, light-filled and have escalators and elevators for quick, convenient access to the terminals. The APM is the centerpiece of LAX's Landside Access Modernization Program (LAMP), which also includes a Consolidated Rent-A-Car (ConRAC) facility, Intermodal Transportation Facilities and associated roadway improvements. The APM will reduce vehicle congestion in the Central Terminal Area, provide a connection with L.A. Metro's regional transportation system, create new locations for passenger pick-up and drop-off, reduce emissions and provide reliable access to the terminals.
